Author Policy

The International Journal of Advances and Applications in Convergent Studies & transdisciplinary (IJ-AACST) expects authors to uphold the highest standards of academic integrity, originality, and ethical conduct. Submission of a manuscript to IJ-AACST implies that all authors agree to the following policies:

1. Originality and Plagiarism

- Manuscripts must be original and unpublished.
- They must not be under consideration by another journal or conference at the time of submission.
- Similarity index must be ≤10% (excluding references and quotations). Papers exceeding this limit will be returned for revision or rejected.

2. Authorship Criteria

- Only individuals who have substantially contributed to the conception, design, execution, or interpretation of the research should be listed as authors.
- The Corresponding Author must obtain consent from all co-authors before submission.
- All co-authors must sign a No Objection Certificate (NOC) authorizing the Corresponding Author to communicate with the journal.

3. Multiple, Redundant, or Concurrent Submissions

- Authors must not submit the same manuscript to more than one journal or primary publication at the same time.
- Duplicate or redundant publication is considered unethical and may lead to rejection or retraction.

4. Data Integrity and Research Ethics

- Authors must present an accurate account of their research. Data should be honestly collected, analyzed, and reported.
- Manipulation, falsification, or fabrication of data constitutes academic misconduct.
- For studies involving humans or animals, an Ethical Approval Statement must be included in the manuscript.

Author Policy

5. Conflict of Interest

- Authors must declare any financial or personal relationships that could inappropriately influence their research.
- If no conflicts exist, the statement "The authors declare no conflict of interest" must be included.

6. Acknowledgment of Sources

- Proper acknowledgment of the work of others is mandatory.
- Authors must cite all sources that have influenced their work.

7. Copyright and Licensing

- Authors retain copyright of their work.
- All articles are published under Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International License (CC
 BY 4.0), which permits use, distribution, and reproduction provided proper credit is given.

8. Revisions and Corrections

- Authors must cooperate with editors and reviewers by responding to comments and revising manuscripts promptly.
- If a significant error is discovered after publication, the authors are obliged to notify the editor immediately and cooperate in issuing a **correction**, **erratum**, **or retraction**.

9. Withdrawal and Retraction Policy

- Withdrawal requests are only accepted before the paper is accepted for publication, and must be approved by all authors.
- After publication, papers may be retracted for proven cases of plagiarism, duplication, data manipulation, or ethical violations.

10. Use of Generative AI Tools

- Authors must disclose the use of any Al-generated content or assistance (e.g., ChatGPT, Grammarly) in the manuscript. Al tools may be used to improve language or clarity but must not be credited as authors.
- No generative AI tool should be used to fabricate data, conduct analysis, or interpret results.
