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- **MASTER Dr. S. B. Kishor**, Associate Professor and Head of the Computer Science Department, has been serving at Sardar Patel Mahavidyalaya, Chandrapur, Maharashtra, India.
- He has a total of 25 years of teaching experience, with 14 years dedicated specifically to active Research Supervisory Experience.
- He is the President of the National-Level Association of All Computer Science Teachers (AACST), and Editor-in-Chief of **International Journal of Advances and Applications in Convergent Studies & Transdisciplinary (IJ-AACST)**.
- Dr. Kishor presently working as Chairman of IT and Application Board (2014–2022 and now from Dec. 2024 till date as an Ad-hoc Chairman) and served as a member of the Academic Council at Gondwana University, Gadchiroli
- He holds two Ph.D. degrees in professional disciplines, including Computer Science and Management.
- He has been granted Seven patents, including Australian ones, and holds Four copyrights.
- Dr. Kishor created his chatbot, SBK_GPT, to assist Computer Science and IT students.
- Under his guidance, **15** researchers have earned a Ph.D., and six scholars have been awarded an M.Phil. and examine many PhD. Thesis at different universities.
- He has been a resource person over 175 times at various national and international conferences, UGC-HRDC, MMTTC, Academic Staff Colleges, Ph.D. coursework programs, Teaching Learning Centers, and more.
